

Installing WAP extension for EMU Webmail 4.5 can be easy and painless.

Simply type,

```
./emuinstall.sh
```

This will start the installation script. This script will ask you a few easy questions before doing the installation. When the script completes you will have WAP functionality in your EMU Webmail installation.

IMPORTANT:

It is required that you configure your web server to properly serve WAP files. In most cases, this will require only a very small addition. Here is an example for the Apache web server, assuming your Webmail installation resides at /home/emumail,

```
<Directory /home/emumail/html>  
  
    DirectoryIndex emumail.fcgi index.html  
  
    AddType text/vnd.wap.wml .wml  
    AddType image/vnd.wap.wbmp .wbmp  
    AddType application/vnd.wap.wmlc .wmlc  
    AddType text/vnd.wap.wmlscript .wmls  
    AddType application/vnd.wap.wmlscriptc .wmlsc  
</Directory>
```

Note: If you are not using FastCGI, the 'DirectoryIndex' directive above should specify 'emumail.cgi' in place of 'emumail.fcgi'.
